This is with reference to Recruitment to above posts On DIRECT RECRUITMENT BASIS Vide Advertisement No: Admn/Estt/02/2018-AIIMS.JDH Dated: $5^{th} - 11^{th}$ January, 2019

No fresh applications are invited in this regard. The notice applied for candidates who have applied on or before 4th February, 2019.

As there will be Computer Based Examination (CBT) for selection.

The CBT Examination will be conducted in various centres for the above said Posts.

- The Indicative Syllabus for all 5 posts has been advertised already and is supposed to judge General Intelligence, General Awareness including the GFR rules, quantitative aptitude and English language and any other skills as needed by the Institute. The syllabus however is indicative and questions may assess any domain as decided by the Institute.

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4.	Scheme of Examination	 200 MCQs of 200 marks with four alternatives for each question. In MCQ Exam, There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. The qualifying marks in Recruitment Examination will be 40% for UR, 35% for OBC,30% for SC & ST and 30% for PwD. 	
5.	Syllabus of Examination	Indicative Syllabus already published on website with detailed advertisement.	
6.	Resolution of Tie Cases	 (i) First by using date of birth with older candidates placed higher. (ii) If not resolved by (i), or in cases with same marks and same date of birth: number of wrong answers / negative marks will be used wherein those with less wrong answers / negative marks will be placed higher. 	

3. Merit will be prepared separately for each post. Only candidates who had filled application for a particular post will be considered for ranking in merit for that particular post.

4. Scribe: Only candidates with VH or Disability in dominant hand with more than 40% disability or Cerebral Palsy, who have already filled and opted for scribe in their online applications will be allowed to bring their own scribe as per guidelines of Government of India with scribe having qualifications lesser than the candidate, bringing his / her Government approved ID and signing all required declarations at the examination venue will be allowed for scribe.

Note: Filling of complete information in Application Form including photograph / signature / Government ID etc. was MANDATORY for all candidates. ACCORDINGLY, CANDIDATES WHO DID NOT RESPONDED WILL NOT ALLOWED TO APPEAR IN THE EXAMINATION.

Candidates who have filled **MULTIPLE APPLICATION** forms with same or little different details will be allowed to sit only once against only one of the application form which was filled most recent. Candidates are advised to assure that they should download admit card and appear for the examination only using their latest application. Any candidate found with multiple admit cards or using any unfair practise will be disqualified from the examination before the admission to venue or even at any stage of examination. Appropriate legal action can be taken against them by the competent authority.

Only website generated Admit Cards will be treated as authentic and permissible to appear in the said Examination. **No admit card will be sent by post**.
